## **#20 First French Town Liberated**

Sainte-Mere-Eglise was a key location in the line of defense along the road to Omaha Beach. During the Normandy invasion, 30 paratroopers landed in the town of Sainte-Mère-Eglise, including 20 on the church square. German soldiers counterattacked and a battle raged on for two days.

Subsequently, Sainte-Mere-Eglise would become the first town in France liberated by Allied troops.
